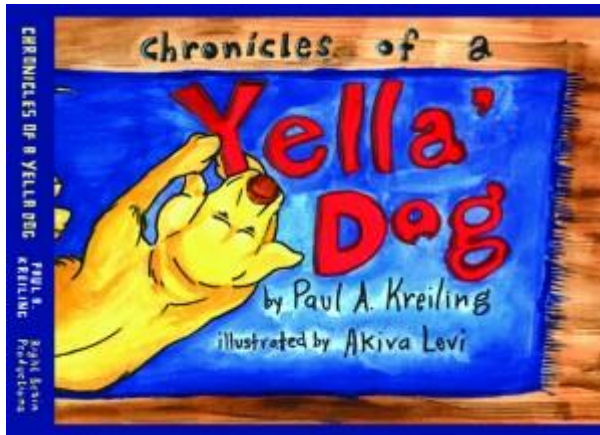


Book Review: Chronicles of a Yella' Dog
